

## Privacy policy

In accordance with the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (hereinafter: **GDPR**) we have harmonised our operations related to the processing and protection of personal data, and as regulated by this Privacy Policy of Alice in Blockchains – Fintech, Crypto and Blockchain Association (hereinafter: Policy).

Alice in Blockchains – Fintech, Crypto and Blockchain Association (hereinafter: **Association**) at its headquarters at Trg Žrtava fašizma 6, 10000 Zagreb, as controller of your personal data, uses and protects all information that you submit to us when you use our website.

**Personal data** means any information relating to an identified or identifiable natural person. An identifiable natural person is one who can be identified, directly or indirectly, in particular by reference to an identifier such as a name, an identification number, location data, an online identifier or to one or more factors specific to the physical, physiological, genetic, mental, economic, cultural or social identity of that natural person.

**Data processing** means any operation or set of operations which is performed on personal data or on sets of personal data, whether or not by automated means, such as collection, recording, organisation, structuring, storage, adaptation or alteration, retrieval, consultation, use, disclosure by transmission, dissemination or otherwise making available, alignment or combination, restriction, erasure or destruction.

**Consent** refers to any freely given, specific, informed and unambiguous indication of the data subject's wishes by which he or she, by a statement or by a clear affirmative action, signifies agreement to the processing of personal data relating to her.

### **Purpose and legal grounds of processing**

The purpose of processing your personal data is to keep records of your membership in the Association. The legal grounds for the processing of your data is provided for in the Law on Associations (Official Gazette No. 74/14), according to which the Association is obliged to keep a list of its members with mandatory personal data referring to the name, surname, personal identification number, date of birth, date of becoming a member, and may also contain other data that are personal data.

The personal data that the Association collects are your (i) name and surname, (ii) e-mail address, (iii) date of birth and (iv) personal identification number.

You independently decide which personal data you will provide the Association with when becoming a member, but we must emphasise that by refusing to provide the mandatory data prescribed in Art. 12 of the Law on Associations (Official Gazette no. 74/14) cannot become a member of the Association.

In accordance with the purpose of processing, the Association will process your personal data exclusively for (i) verification of membership in the Association, (ii) verification of the obligation to pay the membership fee, (iii) verification of the accuracy and correctness, i.e., updating personal data, and (iv) e-mail communication with the member concerning the Association's activities.

In any case and at any time, you can revoke the given consent, send a request for restriction of processing, or any similar objection to which you are entitled in accordance with the GDPR, and we will act according to your request.

#### **How we collect personal data**

We collect your personal data when you contact us directly via our website by submitting the become a member form. If you are under the age of 16, please refrain from providing us with any information without the consent of your parent or guardian.

#### **How we process personal data**

Your personal data will be processed in accordance with the lawfulness of processing principle as laid out in Clause 6 (1) of the GDPR.

By filling out the become a member form or registering on the website [www.aliceinblockchains.io](http://www.aliceinblockchains.io), you give your consent to the processing of your personal data specified in the registration form for the purposes referred to herein.

In addition, we will process your personal data for the purpose of sending notifications to your e-mail addresses concerning news, events, educations, projects, activities, surveys and others, which the Association carries out for the purpose of improving and protecting your rights as members of the Association. If you participate in one of our meetups, trainings and workshops, then your data, photos and video materials recorded as part of such activities may be used for marketing and promotional purposes. We use your personal data for marketing purposes only with your consent. You can revoke the use of your data in the legally permitted framework for marketing activities at any time by sending an e-mail to the address [info@aliceinblockchains.io](mailto:info@aliceinblockchains.io) with the indication "revocation of consent".

Any person can object to the processing of data for the purpose referred to herein at any time, as well as to exercise any of the rights granted to the data subject pursuant to the GDPR.

In the event that you no longer want us to process your data in any way, or require deletion, or correction or transfer of your data, we kindly ask you to notify us via email at [info@aliceinblockchains.io](mailto:info@aliceinblockchains.io). We may contact you to verify the authenticity of the request.

#### **How we store personal data**

Your data is stored on a secure server and will be erased upon your request. All your information is stored on our secure servers and is accessed and used in accordance with our security policies and standards.

Privacy protection of your data is permanent, and we take all necessary measures to protect it. We process personal data in a secure manner, including protection against unauthorised or illegal processing and against loss.

We undertake to protect the privacy of the personal data of all members as data subjects, and we will treat them in accordance with the GDPR and other applicable laws and regulations in force. We undertake not to misuse personal data from the become a member form, nor to hand them over to

third parties without your permission, except in cases where the law expressly requires us to do so and where necessary as provided for in applicable mandatory laws and regulations.

All your data are safely stored and are only available to those who need the data to perform their work and undertaken activities. All our employees are responsible for respecting the principles of data privacy laid down in the GDPR. We are committed to protecting your personal data in such a way that we only collect basic data about our members that are necessary for the fulfilment of obligations. The data that is automatically recorded and stored when accessing the website (IP address, domain name, browser types, number of visits, time spent on the pages, etc.) will be used exclusively for the purpose of evaluating website visits and improving its content and functionality, i.e., for statistical and security purposes.

**Period for which the personal data will be stored**

We will store your personal data for the time necessary to achieve the purposes referred to herein, i.e., as long as you wish to remain in contact with us and as long as you wish to receive our notifications in accordance with the consent you gave us when joining the membership of the Association, i.e., until you withdraw the consent you gave us for certain purposes.

If and when we receive your request for erasure, revocation of consent, request for restriction of processing of your personal data, or any similar objection, we will immediately act according to your request, and storing personal data within a certain period will be the only way of processing them before their permanent deletion. You can exercise the aforementioned rights by sending a written request to [info@aliceinblockchains.io](mailto:info@aliceinblockchains.io). The data that must be kept for a specific period of time according to mandatory laws and regulations in the field of accounting and tax law will not be deleted.
